

Stereo Cabinet

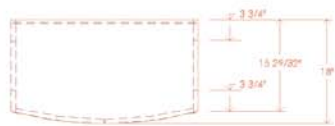


A simple cabinet designed to contain a compact stereo system. The client stipulated that all components including the speakers should be accommodated in the cabinet such that there was as little evidence as possible of its existence. His apartment features furnishings and art that emphasize rich surfaces and fine craftsmanship.

My approach was to create a cabinet which while fitting into the "luxe" atmosphere of the surroundings didn't fight with them for attention. The process was one of paring down features to a coherent minimum.

The inside is actually more complex than the outside with shelving sized and arranged to squeeze the components into the envelope. Screens were placed in the gables to provide audio transparency.

Materials: Figured Makore veneers, solid makore, stainless steel mesh.
